



ANTI COVID PROTOCOL

A proper anti Covid protocol has been elaborated in order to ensure that all activities at Fondazione Alessandro Volta are carried out safely and in compliance with COVID related rules for work spaces and meeting areas.

Please find below an excerpt of the protocol regarding the Lake Como School of Advanced Studies activities:

- *participants are informed and reminded about covid rules with a proper signage (in english)*
- *the maximum capacity of the main room, which is normally 50 persons, is now reduced to 30 persons in order to keep seats distanced (1 m.). the speaker should stay at 2 m. from the first row*
- *body temperature may be checked upon entrance, participants with a temperature of 37.5 or higher will not be allowed inside the building*
- *hand sanitizer dispensers are available in different spots and participants will be strongly encouraged to use them*
- *the list of participants will be kept for at least 14 days in order to allow contact tracing if needed*
- *to avoid queues, most school materials (program, invoice, etc) will be provided by email*
- *participants are asked to use always the same seat*
- *coffee breaks and lunches are served, if possible, outside*
- *face masks are compulsory inside the building and outside if distancing is not possible*
- *cleaning and sanification of the meeting room, common areas, toilets are carried out everyday at the end of the lectures*
- *speakers should use hand sanitizers before using the white board and using the laptop or pointer*
- *ventilation is granted by opening windows and doors at the end of each session or by keeping doors and windows constantly open according to the weather conditions*
